

On February 3, the executive committee launched by Nagomi teamed up with Asahi Shimbun Social Welfare Organization and held a workshop on "Creating an Ideal City" at Yume-hat Citizens' Cultural Center in Minami Soma.

Many people from various backgrounds sharing the same goal to "think about how to create the community of Soso area", in addition to those with mental disorders and their family, social welfare workers and medical practitioners gathered together. We learned how to put city planning into actual practice from the lecturers, and through group work discussions, we were able to discuss about our ideals and also share our thoughts on the richness of the Soso area. There were approximately 60 participants,

Woodwork Workshop "Let's enjoy handcraft - woodwork relaxation IN Nagomi"

In February this year, there was a new attempt at our Minami Soma Office. This was the woodwork workshop "Let's enjoy handcraft – woodwork relaxation IN Nagomi" which was held aiming for relaxation and change of mood. We used palm-sized pieces of wood provided by litate-mura Forest Owners' Cooperative, chopped, carved, and polished them and made them into leaves or cat shapes that each of us designed ourselves.



Participants used electric scroll saws, knives, carving knives, and files with assistance of Nagomi staff members, and concentrated in making the woodworks. Conversations such as "It's the first time since elementary school class that I used a scroll saw" and "I wanted to continue filing till I was completely satisfied" were heard.

The questionnaires that the participants filled out showed that most of them were satisfied with the workshop commenting that "I am satisfied with what we did in the workshop", "It helped to my mood". We believe that the woodwork workshop turned out to be a success for now!

This workshop was held also with the aim to "create a place to prevent isolation" and "provide an opportunity to make Nagomi known". There were

points that need to be reviewed and areas which need improvement, but we will aim at making this a regular event of Nagomi. (Orikasa, Visiting Nurse)
